

## **Ashfield & Hilltowns Police Co-Response Clinician**

The Town of Ashfield, acting as the lead town on behalf of ten towns, seeks a qualified individual to serve as a part-time Police Co-Response Clinician. This position requires an organized, empathetic, and hard-working individual to assist police departments on mental health crises calls utilizing intervention and de-escalation techniques. This non-benefitted position is paid \$50.00 per hour for 19.50 hours per week. Night and weekend work may be required. A full job description can be found on the town website.

Minimum requirements include a master's degree in counseling, psychology, or related field, and two years' experience in crisis work. Experience collaborating with law enforcement is preferred.
