

## INVITATION FOR BIDS

### BRIDGE #A-13-024 – WILLIAMSBURG ROAD OVER CREAMERY BROOK

The Town of Ashfield (“The Town”) will accept sealed bids for repair of a bridge structure on Williamsburg Road over Creamery Brook in Ashfield, Massachusetts.

Sealed bids should be marked "WILLIAMSBURG BRIDGE BIDS" and will be received by The Town until March 23, 2026 at 12 PM. The clock in Lower Hall of Ashfield Town Hall will be the sole determination of time. Bids received after the deadline will not be accepted. If the Town Hall is closed for any reason, bids will be opened the following business day at 12PM.

MassDOT prequalification of contractors with the class of work as, Bridge - Construction, for the project with an estimated value of \$82,594 will be required. Contractors should confirm their eligibility prior to submitting bids. Qualified bidders who are Minority/Women/Disabled Owned Business Enterprises (M/W/D/BE) businesses are encouraged to apply. Other qualified bidders are encouraged to partner with disadvantaged businesses. A listing of certified disadvantaged businesses can be found at <http://www.mass.gov/sdo>. Affirmative Action, Equal Opportunity, and Workforce Participation goals apply.

Wage rates for this bid are subject to prevailing wage rates as per MGL Chapter 149, Section 26 - 27f inclusive. This bid is being undertaken per MGL Ch 30 §39M requiring a 5% bid bond/deposit and 50% Labor and Materials Payment Bond.

There will be no pre-bid conference, but appointments can be made to view the site with the Highway Department by calling 413-628-4448.

The Town of Ashfield is the awarding authority and reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids in total or in part as they may deem in the best public interest.
