## ARTICLE 1: Sewer/WWTP Enterprise Fund Budget Adjustment

To see if the Town will vote to correct Article 23 of the Annual Town Meeting Warrant and appropriate the additional sum of \$4,500 for the Sewer/WWTP Enterprise Fund for the Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 2019, in accordance with the provisions of M.G.L. c.44, §53F½, the amounts to be funded from the following sources, or act relative thereto.

Any person or organization who shall violate any of the provisions of this Bylaw may be fined in the amount of \$300.00, which shall inure to the Town for each violation in accordance with M.G.L. Chapter 40 Section 21D;

Or act relative thereto.

**Quantum Vote Required: Majority**


